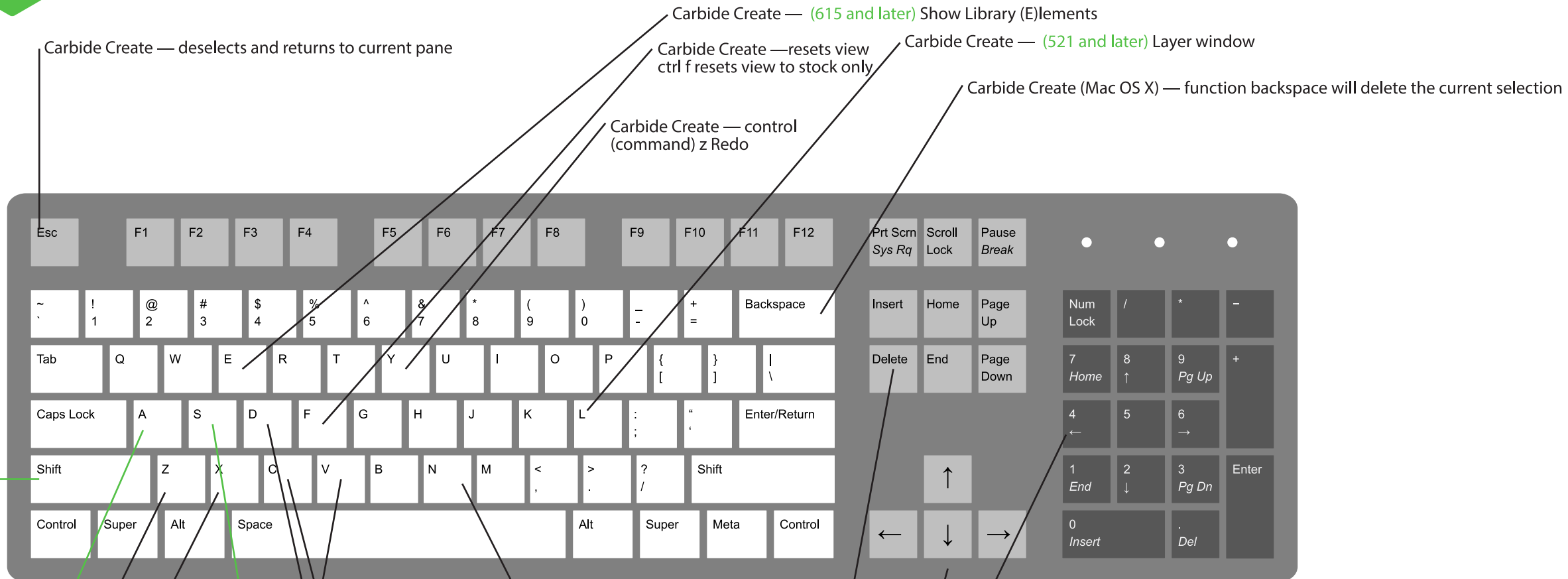




Carbide 3D

Keyboard Shortcuts for Carbide Create



Carbide Create — deselects and returns to current pane

Carbide Create — (615 and later) Show Library (E)lements

Carbide Create —resets view
ctrl f resets view to stock only

Carbide Create — (521 and later) Layer window

Carbide Create — control
(command) z Redo

Carbide Create (Mac OS X) — function backspace will delete the current selection

Carbide Create — control
(command) c copy
the current selection v paste

Carbide Create — control
(command) d duplicate
the current selection. Node edit
delete selected nodes

Carbide Create — node edit
toggle smooth/sharp

Carbide Create (473 or later)
— enter/exit Node Edit mode

Carbide Create —
click-hold-drag on
empty area to select
dragging up will select
any object even partially
in the selection area,
down will only select
objects entirely within
the marquee

Carbide Create — Zoom in/out in
design/3D preview.

Carbide Create —
click-hold-drag on
empty area to pan

click-hold dragging on
a selection will move
it (with snapping
if enabled)

right-click (or control-
click on toolpaths or
group headings in the
Toolpath pane
for a menu which allows
deletion, or on paths
while node editing for
options.

Create — nudge selection

Carbide Create — delete will delete the current selection

Carbide Create — control (command) x delete the current selection

Carbide Create — control (command) z Undo

Carbide Create — control (command) a will select everything

Carbide Create — shift- (414 and later) or control- (413 and earlier) clicking on geometry will add or remove it from the current selection
